SELF DEFENSE CLASS

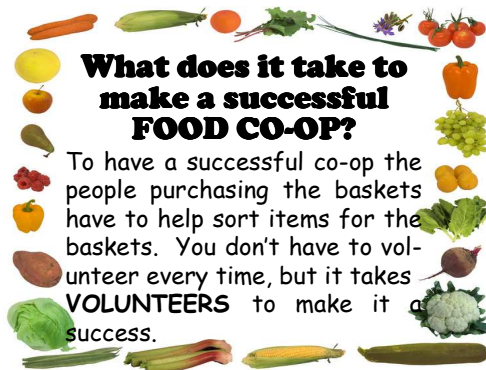
PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED
